Graphemes

English alphabetic code

- 44 sounds
- 26 letters
- Over 150+ graphemes (letter combinations)

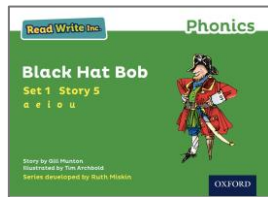

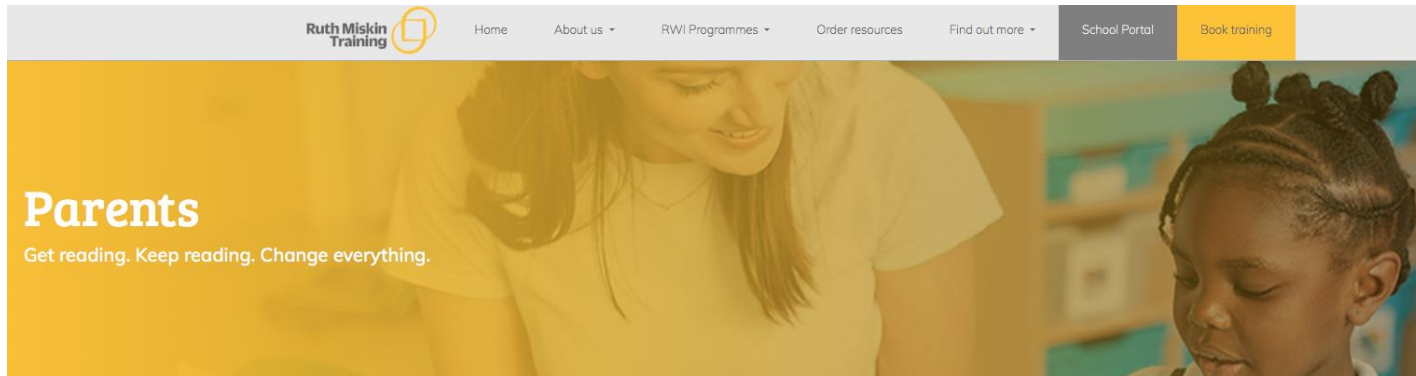

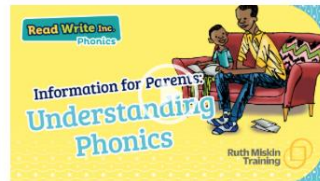


Read Write Inc. Phonics – information for parents

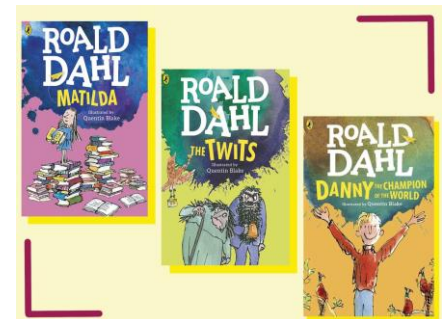

English Lessons

When children have completed the RWI programme, they go on into formal English lessons that are also one hour long.

Children will bring home short chapter books, that gradually get longer and harder.

Here is how you can help your child read these.



Greater depth readers need to be able to:

Make connections between books they are reading and books they have read:

For example:

- characters
- settings
- themes

E.g. Roald Dahl often has children who are hard done by. There are usually some eccentric characters. Normally the hard done to child is successful in the end.
