## Physical Development:

To know how to:

- negotiate space successfully, adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles.
- collaborate with others to manage large items, such as tyres or large planks.
- use scissors to accurately cut along a line.
- fasten my own zip and buttons independently
- use my body to create a range of movements for different purposes.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

To know how to:

- be flexible and cooperate with others.
- understand the needs, wants and behaviours of others.
- ask an adult for help to resolve a conflict.
- be confident speaking within a familiar group.
- seek support for my emotions from an adult.
- listen to the ideas of others in play.
- brush my teeth and why know it is important.
- discuss why sleep is important.
- independently put on aprons, overalls, boots and helmets.

## Communication and Language:

To know how to:

- understand a range of complex sentence structures.
- understand humour.
- respond to others in conversation or discussion.
- remember new vocabulary.
- connect actions or ideas using a range of connectives.

## Literacy: To know how to:

- re-enact stories I have heard in my play.
- describe main story settings, events and characters in increasing detail.
- recognise some written names of peers or familiar people.
- write all the letters of my name.
- continue a rhyming string.
- use my phonic knowledge to decode simple words.
- correctly write the sounds for simple CV and CVC words.
- form all the letters of the alphabet correctly.

## Mathematics: To know how to:

- identify and describe 2D shapes- circles, triangles, rectangles and squares.
- count from 0-5, identify one more and one less, subitise amounts and talk about the composition of numbers 1-5.

## Expressive Arts and Design: To know how to:

- use more complex tools when creating- pastels, masking tape, PVA glue.
- experiment with different materials, colours and textures.
- learn the words to some unfamiliar songs.

## Understanding the World: To know:

- we are in the season autumn and what changes can be observed.
- about some celebrations at this time of year- bonfire night, Christmas, Remembrance Day.
- how to comment on important figures from the past- Guy Fawkes.
- the name of the country I live in.
- where my school is located and what is around us on the map.
- the names of some countries around the world.
- some similarities and differences about life in this country and others.
- who our local vicar is and visit the church where they work.
- who is important to members of religious groups.
- why Christians perform Nativity plays at Christmas.
